



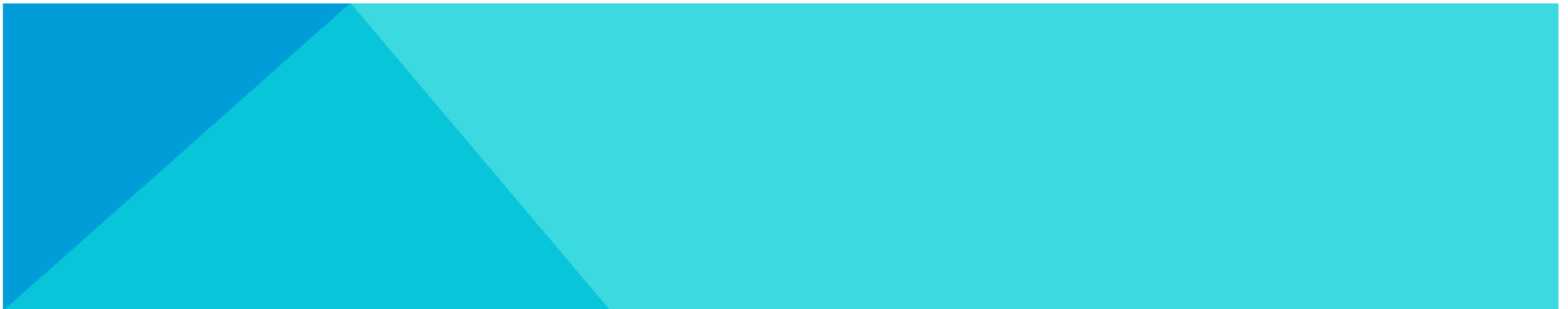

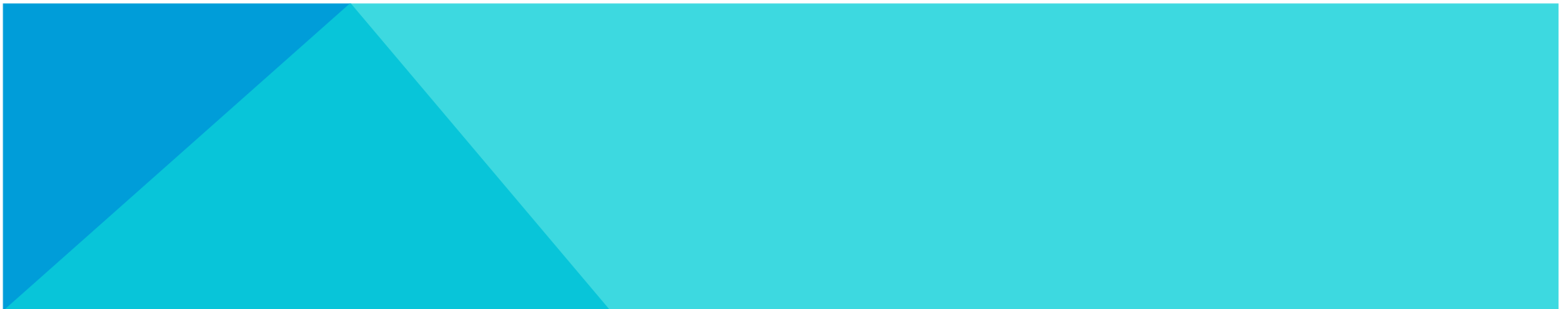

IMMEDIATE CHALLENGES

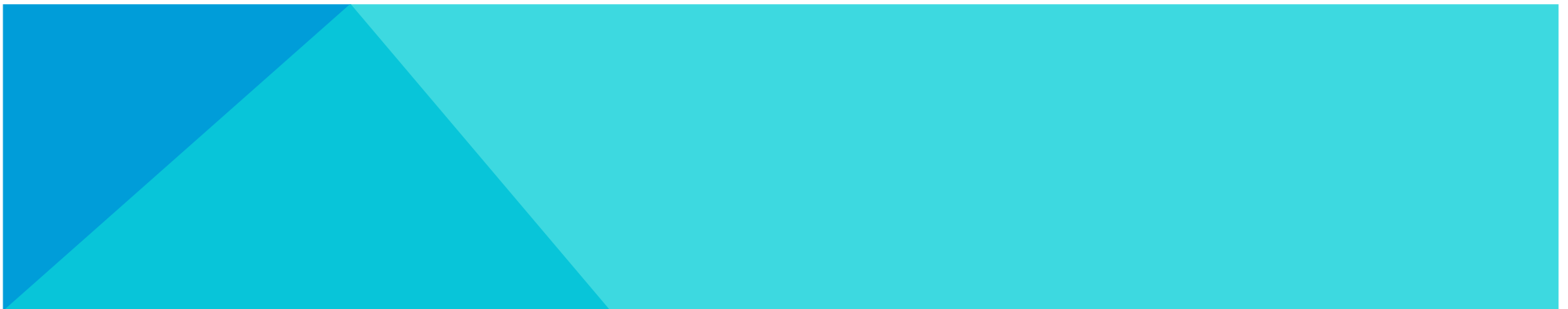
- **At work:** Ageing workforce, changing demographics, nature of work, health issues, occupational health vs health and wellness?

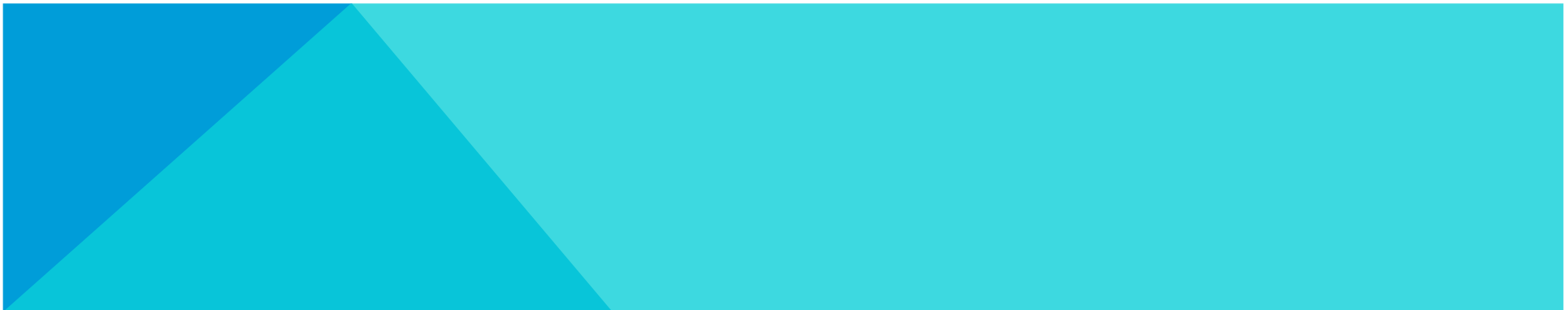

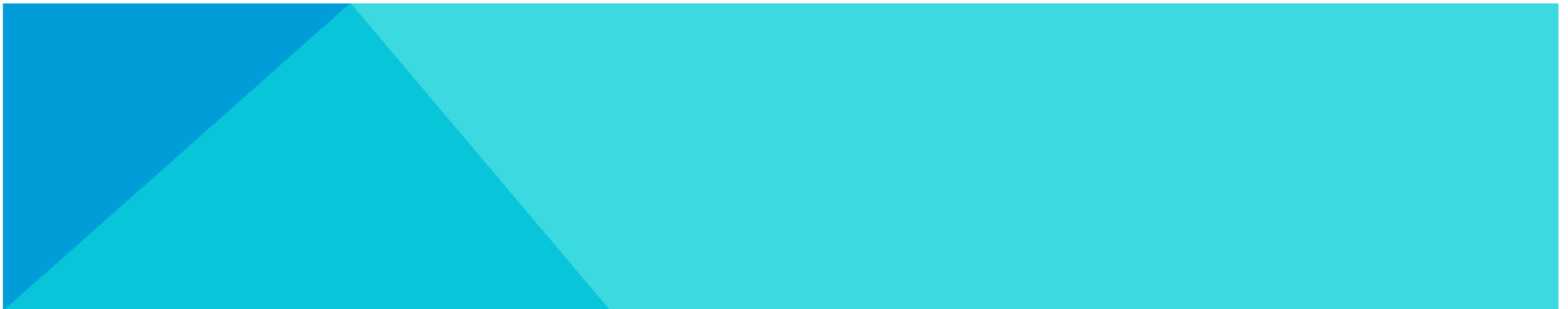
THE VOICE OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSING

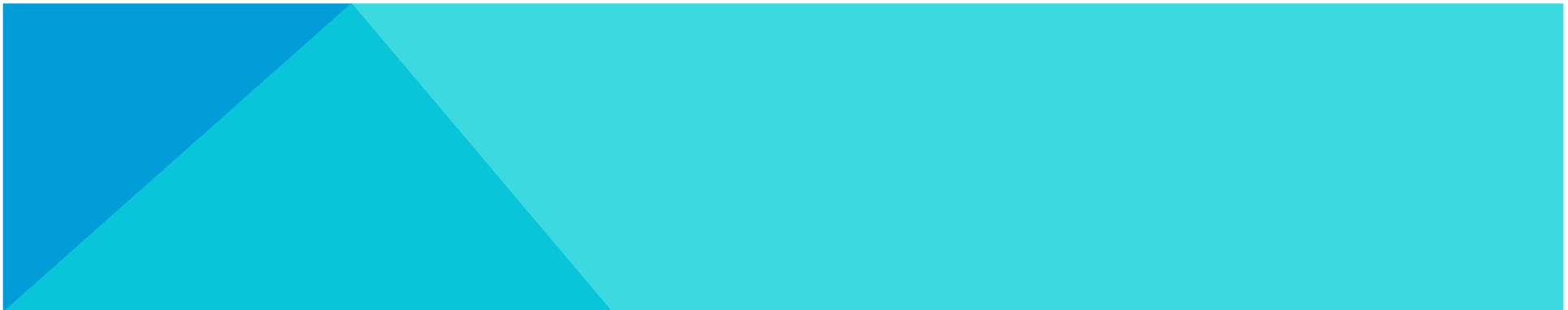
Our vision is to promote excellence in the education, research and evidence based practice of all occupational health nurses for the benefit of the working population.
